Kidman Bridge Renewal Works

Works Notice

We are undertaking remediation works on Kidman Bridge, located over the River Torrens.

These works, funded by the South Australian Government as part of the Bridge Maintenance Program, will ensure long term protection of the steelwork and increase the life span of the bridge.

What's happening

Maintenance works are continuing on Kidman Bridge, located over the River Torrens, on Henley Beach Road.

From Monday 28 October 2024 to early December 2024 further pedestrian restrictions will be in place on the bridge footpath (over the River Torrens on Henley Beach Road).

How this affects you

Pedestrian access to the northern and southern bridge footpaths will be closed intermittently. One footpath will remain open at all times. Onsite signage will be in place to direct pedestrians.

Outside of working hours footpath closures on Kidman Bridge will remain in place until early December 2024, weather permitting.

Sections of the Linear Park Trail Shared Use Path under Kidman Bridge will remain closed with local detours in place until further notice. Onsite signage is in place to direct pedestrians.

For everyone's safety, the current speed restrictions on Henley Beach Road will remain in place as required, for the duration of the project. Please observe signage and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

During the works, there will be some noisy activities at times, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

All works on Kidman Bridge are expected to be complete in mid-2025.
