

South Road, Mile End Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Project Update

We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians and cyclists to cross South Road

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, and urban roads, and footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia. The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments over three years.

What's happening

We are installing a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on South Road at the intersection of Roebuck Street and King Street, Mile End.

This will improve pedestrian and cyclists safety and access to nearby retail shops, businesses and homes, while improving bicycle and pedestrian connectivity across South Road.

Preliminary works have been completed and major works are expected to commence in early 2025.
