Works Commencement Notice

We are installing a new Koala Crossing on East Terrace, Strathalbyn as part of the Road Safety Program.

The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over three years.

What's happening

Works are starting from Thursday, 5 December 2024, including vegetation maintenance and installation of a new Koala Crossing on East Terrace, near Chapel Street in Strathalbyn.

This crossing will improve safety and access, particularly for the local schools. See concept design overleaf.

The existing Koala Crossing currently located near Rowe Street will remain.

How this affects you

On **Thursday, 5 December 2024**, vegetation maintenance will be undertaken to improve the visibility of signage on East Terrace, between Rowe Street and Chapel Street. Some speed and parking restrictions will be in place while works are being undertaken.

Construction of the new Koala Crossing will start from **Monday**, **9 December 2024** and is expected to be completed by late-January 2025.

Between Tuesday, 10 December 2024 and Thursday, 12 December 2024, a section of East Terrace will be reduced to a single lane with traffic controllers in place to manage the flow of traffic between Rowe Street and Chapel Street.

Access to the school will be maintained.
