

Springbank Road, Colonel Light Gardens Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Night works

We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians and cyclists to cross Springbank Road, Colonel Light Gardens

This project is funded by the \$168 million Road Safety Program, jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments.

What's happening

Works on the new Pedestrian Actuated Crossing on Springbank Road in Colonel Light Gardens and Panorama are underway and progressing well.

To facilitate the next stages of works, including asphaltting and line marking, **night works are required intermittently from Sunday 9 November 2025 until mid-December 2025, weather permitting.**

Advance notice will be provided to local residents prior to the commencement of night works.

Day works will continue.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, Eliza Place and Freeling Crescent will be closed intermittently until project completion in December 2025. Local access detours will be in place during closures with advance notice to be provided via onsite signage.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow directional signage.

Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours, until completion.
