

# Variable message gantry signage installation

## Works notice – upcoming night works

We are installing new variable message gantry signage at 16 locations along the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) corridor and surrounding major travel routes.

Variable message gantry signage displays live travel-time estimates, as well as alternative routes or roadworks notifications as needed. This information helps drivers make informed decisions while on their journey.

## What's happening

Stage 2 of works to install the new variable message gantry signage at Shepherds Hill Road will commence from late May 2026. Works will occur intermittently for approximately three weeks.

To minimise disruption to all road users, works will be undertaken at night, between the hours of 8pm and 5am, from Sunday to Thursday.

This stage of works will include:

- piling works
- Installation of temporary barriers.

**Piling works will occur in the central median of Shepherds Hill Road, between Donnybrook Road and Depindo Avenue from Thursday, 28 May and take approximately one week to complete.**

There will be some noise disturbance while these works are completed. However, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.

## How this affects you

### Pedestrians and road users

Shepherds Hill Road will remain open at all times during the works, with intermittent speed and lane restrictions in place. Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Short-term pedestrian detours may be required at times to safely facilitate works. Clear signage will be in place during these times to direct pedestrians.

### Residents and businesses

Further stages of night work will be required. Advance notice will be provided to adjacent residents and businesses prior to these works.

Access to businesses and residents will be maintained throughout the works, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
