# **SAFETY ALERT**

### **Incident Title:**

Circular Saw Injury

### **Date of Incident:**

July 2016

### **Injury Description and Details:**

A Contractor cut his finger and partially severed a tendon whilst using a circular saw cutting strips of plywood. The strips of plywood were being used as support for formwork shutters. Micro-surgery on his finger was required.

SafeWork SA was notified by the Contractor and two Improvement Notices were issued.

Outcome of this incident could have been very different if the finger had been completely severed, resulting in a permanent disability.

## A reminder to all workers to ensure safe operation of plant:

- o Adjust depth of blade
- o Blade guard in place
- o Keep body parts away from cutting blade
- o Clamp material to prevent unexpected movement
- Wear hearing and eye protection
