➤ **A direct link connecting Port Adelaide and the Coast**
A safer street for all road users

➤ **A walkable environment**
Better access to community facilities for people of all ages and abilities

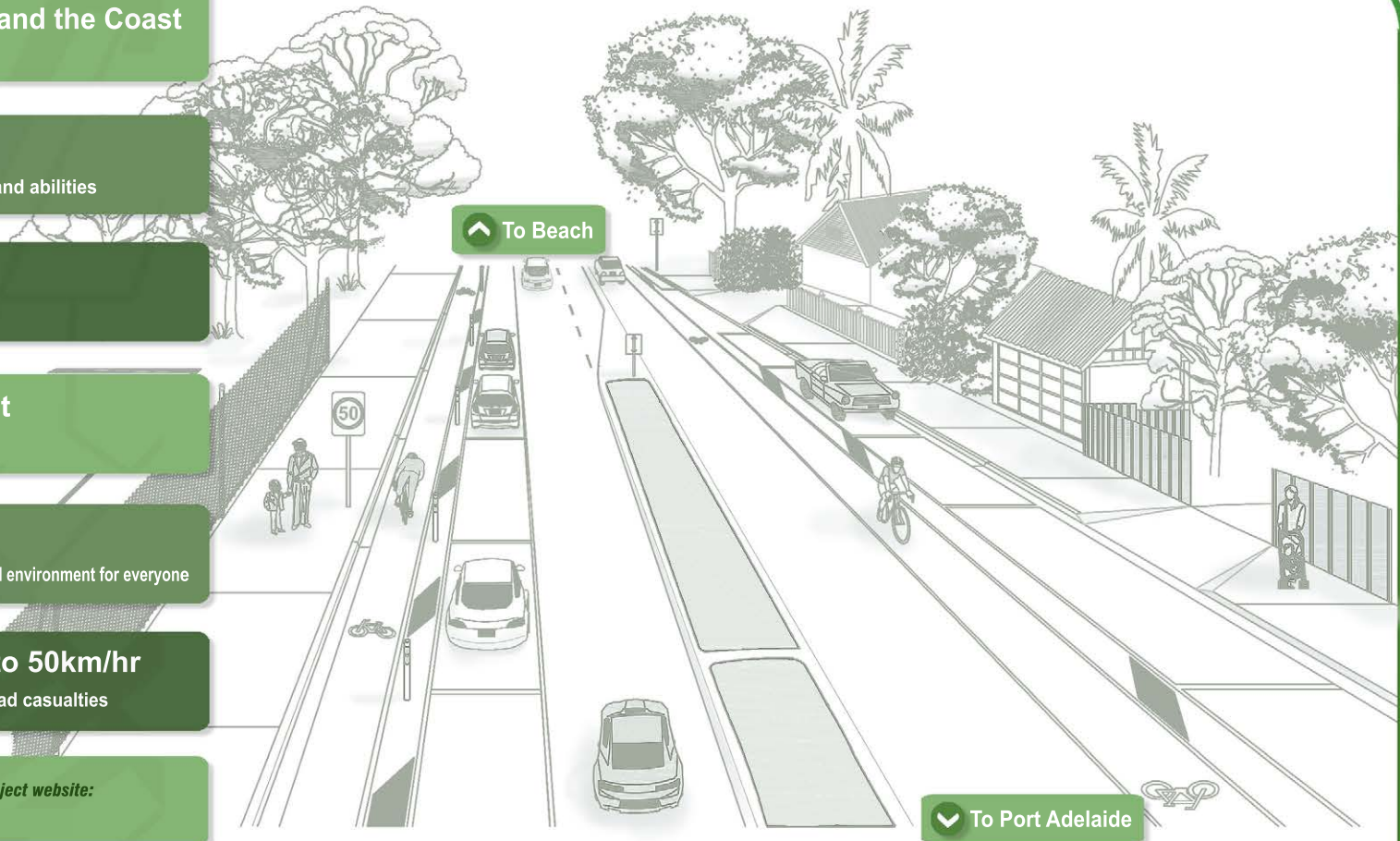
➤ **Protected bike lanes**
New buffers to protect people riding bicycles

➤ **Enhanced look and feel of Hart Street**
Creating a healthy, friendly neighbourhood

➤ **Lane reduction**
Removal of surplus traffic lanes, delivering an appropriate, balanced road environment for everyone

➤ **Speed limit reduction from 60km/hr to 50km/hr**
Reduce vehicle speeds to support safety, leading to fewer road casualties

Removal of one travel lane in each direction for the length of Hart Street between the Jervois Bridge and Military Road

Modify the intersection of Carlisle and Hart Street to improve safety for everyone

Pedestrian crossing points



Enhancement of existing school koala crossing at Le Fevre High School

Installation of protected bike lanes along Hart Street
