The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the Skillies Bridge, Balaklava Road, between Halbury and Auburn.

This work is part of the \$40 million Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program, which will improve road safety and increase freight efficiency by upgrading bridges across South Australia's regional road network.

Works on the Skillies Bridge are scheduled to commence from Monday, **4 March**, **and are expected to be completed June**, weather permitting, and will include:

- replacing the existing bridge with wider structures
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday each week until the completion of the project.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.

Lane and speed restrictions will be in place throughout the course of the works.

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
