



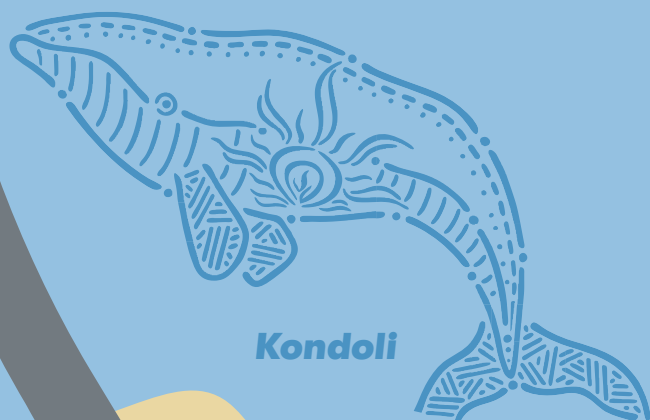

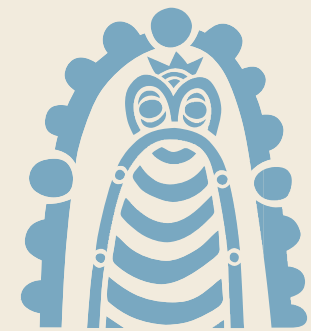
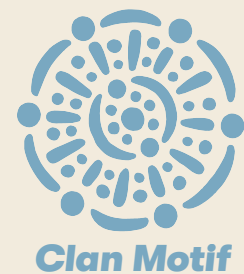
### Design considerations

- Installation of a new and improved boat ramp.

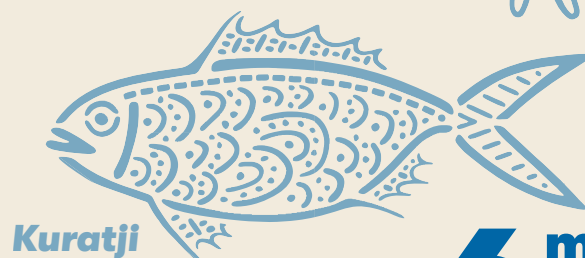


## Ngarrindjeri-Ramindjeri Artists Design Motifs
