Tram Grade Separations Project

Initial site investigation activities

The Australian and South Australian governments recently committed \$400 million (50:50) in funding towards removing the level crossings from the Glenelg tram line at Marion Road and Cross Road, Plympton. These works form part of the Tram Grade Separations Project.

We look forward to engaging with the community in the coming months more about this project. This will be an opportunity to share further information about the key insights learnt through the planning work undertaken so far, as well as seek important feedback to help inform the detailed design process.

Upcoming site investigation activities

Service locating works will begin this week. This involves a small team visiting various sites on local roads along the tram line to identify the location of any underground pipes and wires. This work may involve some brief traffic restrictions such as a lowered speed limit or being guided through the small worksite by traffic controllers. The works will take approximately 4 days however, the works will only be undertaken at each location for approximately an hour.

Ground investigation works will then be undertaken for approximately five weeks commencing from **Monday 10 October**. These works are undertaken to develop a further understanding of the underlying soil and groundwater conditions to inform the early planning and design phase. These works will involve a mobile drilling rig undertaking soil samples at various locations. We will provide advance notice for any temporary road closures required for these works.
