Early works

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$85 million (50:50) towards an upgrade of the intersection of Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive, Brooklyn Park.

What's happening:

Early works are commencing, with underground service relocations for SA Water mains being undertaken.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe.

The Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive intersection will always remain open to traffic. Speed and lane restrictions will be required in the vicinity of the works. Please take care when travelling through the area and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

When

Monday 13 May to early June 2024 weather permitting

Hours of operation

Monday – Friday 7pm – 6am

Where

Marion Road, between Sir Donald Bradman Drive and Press Road.

Sir Donald Bradman Drive between Marion Road and Spencer Street

Some bus stops in the area might be affected for a short period of time. Where required, signage will be in place to direct passengers. Please pay attention to the signs at the bus stops and check the latest updates at adelaidemetro.com.au for more information.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access with signage in place to direct to alternative routes.

Properties near the works will have some restricted access. The project team will contact affected property owners, residents, and businesses directly in advance.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, but we will do our best to minimise noise where possible.
