

# Richmond Road and Railway Terrace Intersection Upgrade

## Night works notice

We are upgrading the intersection of Richmond Road and Railway Terrace to relieve congestion and increase future capacity for this key link between the CBD and the western suburbs.

This project, being delivered as part of an \$850 million suite of projects, is designed to ensure Adelaide's road network functions efficiently during construction of the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project, and once it has been completed.

## What's happening:

To assist with the early project planning, ground investigation works will be undertaken in the vicinity of the intersection.

## How this affects you:

To minimise impacts to road users, these works will be undertaken at night intermittently between 7pm and 6am from **Sunday 16 June until late July 2024**, weather permitting.

To do this work safely, temporary lane and speed restrictions will be in place.

Please plan ahead and expect some delays.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed; however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
