Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junctions Upgrade

Night works

Newly installed traffic signals at the intersection of Main Road and Russell Street have been switched on with the intersection fully open to traffic, increasing capacity across the network and improving road safety for all users.

What's happening:

As part of the finishing works around the junction, existing overhead powerlines will be removed and completion of street lighting will shortly be undertaken along Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road within the project area.

How this affects you:

To keep you safe, the following temporary detours will be in place:

- From Monday 1 July to Wednesday 3 July 2024, Elliot Avenue at the corner of Main Road will be closed during the works. Local access will be maintained via Price Avenue. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- On Sunday 7 July 2024, Russell Street will be closed during the works. Main Road will remain open to traffic with speed and lanes restrictions. Please refer to the detour map overleaf.

Observe speed limits, detour signage, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Please plan ahead and expect some delays.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

SA Power Networks will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.
