Rectification Works

We're upgrading key strategic arterial roads in the Adelaide Hills.

This forms part of the \$150 million initiative, jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments over five years.

What's happening

We are continuing to undertake works to improve safety along Onkaparinga Valley Road, in multiple locations. Maintenance works are required to improve the ride quality in this location.

How this affects you

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed restrictions will be in place during working hours with traffic controllers onsite to control the direction of travel.

Please follow traffic management directions and onsite signage while works are in progress. Outside of work hours, speed restrictions will be returned to normal.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.
