Investigation Works – Lobethal Road

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region.

The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening

We are undertaking investigation works on Lobethal Road between Ashton and Lenswood.

These investigations will support planning for potential upgrades along this road.

Works will include engineering and vegetation surveys, and geotechnical and pavement drilling investigations.

How this affects you

Works will be undertaken at various locations with short term speed and lane restrictions in place as required.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Outside of working hours, Lobethal Road will be fully open with no restrictions in place.

Minor noise disturbances can be expected while works are being undertaken, but we will minimise any disturbance to residents as much as practically possible.

Access to properties will be maintained for the duration of works.
