

Anderson Walk, Smithfield Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (BPAC)

Works notice

We are making it safer and more convenient for cyclists and pedestrians to cross Anderson Walk

As part of the South Australian Government's Greenways and Cycle Path Program, we are working in local communities to encourage active travel and provide safe dedicated walking and cycling routes.

What's happening

We are installing a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (BPAC) on Anderson Walk adjacent Smithfield train station.

Works will include:

- installation of a BPAC (push button)
- installation of new traffic signals
- upgraded footpath to improve access and safety for pedestrians and cyclists
- upgraded road lighting
- new line marking and road signage.

The upgrade will improve pedestrian safety and access to nearby retail shops, businesses, homes, and public transport while improving connectivity across Anderson Walk.

The new pedestrian crossing signals will interface with the existing railway signals to facilitate safe traffic and pedestrian movements.

How this affects you

To ensure safety while working in the vicinity of an active rail line the railway crossing on Anderson Walk will be closed to all traffic during night works.

Some intermittent day closures will also be required throughout works. These will be communicated in advance via onsite signage. A vehicle detour will be in place during closures for the duration of works. Please see detour map overleaf for more information.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours, speed restrictions will remain in place as required.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through the area. Some areas may have restricted access, with traffic controllers on site to guide you to alternative routes.

Anderson Walk will be open to traffic at all times over the Easter long weekend, from Friday, 18 April 2025 to Monday, 21 April 2025.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times. Advance notice will be provided if short term access restrictions are required. **Please contact DM Roads on 1300 012 413 for urgent enquiries and access requests outside of business hours.**

There may be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.
