



Raglan Avenue, Edward Street and South Road network upgrade

Landscaping Fact Sheet

Landscape plan

As part of the Raglan Avenue, Edward Street and South Road network upgrade project, we will be planting approximately 150 semi-mature trees and over 5,000 shrubs within the project area.

The new landscaping will increase footpath shade, street appeal and enhance local biodiversity.

We have prepared a concept landscape plan and planting palette that will complement the local biodiversity and streetscape. Tree and shrub species have been carefully selected in consultation with

local Councils to ensure they are suitable to the area.

Landscaping works will commence from mid-2026 and continue until project completion, expected in late 2026, weather permitting. Examples of tree and shrub species selection and a concept landscape plan has been provided over the page.
