Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

Pavement works along Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Roads

Works to install new pavement along Goodwood Road, Springbank Road and Daws Road to facilitate the new four-way intersection, will be undertaken throughout the day and night during the April 2021, school holidays while traffic volumes are lower. This allows works to be completed in a shorter timeframe, minimising the duration of construction impacts to traffic and the surrounding community.

Night works, traffic restrictions and weekend intersection closures will occur from 7pm Friday, 9 April 2021, until late April 2021, with limited access to Goodwood Road from Springbank Road and Daws Road.

During this time, a number of traffic switches will be implemented. Please see maps and additional details overleaf for traffic restrictions.

Signage will be placed at key locations to provide advance notice to motorists of the change in access arrangements. Access will be maintained for buses and emergency services vehicles at all times.

Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site, and observe speed and lane restrictions, traffic controllers and signage when travelling through the area.

Please note that during morning peak periods, two lanes will be maintained for traffic heading north to the city and one lane for traffic heading south on Goodwood Road. This will be reversed for the afternoon peak period.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there will be restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to properties during these works will be maintained, however at times this will be under the assistance of traffic controllers. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.



• Stage 1 (Weekend 1 Daws Road Closure) – From 7pm Friday, 9 April 2021, to 6am Monday, 12 April 2021:




No access available to Goodwood Road from Daws Road.

Northbound lanes (to city) will be closed along Goodwood Road, from Jamestown Avenue to Rockville Avenue, however access will be maintained in both directions along the southbound lanes.

Right turn and left turn access into and out of Springbank Road from Goodwood Road, as well as left turn into Oxford Circus and left turn into and out of Boothby Street will also be maintained.


• Stage 2 (Week 1 Goodwood Road lane restrictions) – From 6am Monday, 12 April 2021, to 7pm Friday, 16 April 2021:



Southbound lanes (to Darlington) will be closed along Goodwood Road, however access will be maintained in both directions along the northbound lanes.

Right turn and left turn access into and out of Springbank Road from Goodwood Road, as well as the right turn and left turn access into and out of Daws Road from Goodwood Road will be maintained.

In addition, left turn into Oxford Circus and left turn into and out of Boothby Street from Goodwood Road will also be maintained. • Stage 3 (Weekend 2 Springbank Road night closures) from 7pm Friday, 16 April 2021, to 6am Monday, 19 April 2021:




The intersection of Springbank Road and Goodwood Road will be closed each night between 7pm to 6am.

Southbound lanes (to Darlington) will be closed on Goodwood Road from Rockville Avenue to Jamestown Avenue, however access will be maintained in both directions along the northbound lanes.

Right turn and left turn access into and out of Daws Road from Goodwood Road, as well as the left turn out of and into Boothby Street from Goodwood Road will also be maintained. However, left turn access into Oxford Circus will be closed.

 Stage 4 (Week 2 Goodwood Road lane restrictions) from 6am Monday, 19 April to 6am Sunday, 25 April 2021:



Northbound lanes (to city) will be closed on Goodwood Road, however access will be maintained in both directions along the southbound lanes.

Right turn and left turn access into and out of Springbank Road from Goodwood Road, as well as the right turn and left turn access into and out of Daws Road from Goodwood Road will also be maintained.

In addition, the left turn into Oxford Circus and left turn into and out of Boothby Street from Goodwood Road will be maintained. Once pavement works are complete, works including the installation of new kerbing, traffic signal infrastructure, footpaths and street lighting, will continue.
