

Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Portrush and Magill roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$98 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

While the majority of works are being undertaken during the day, night works are being undertaken to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Night works to place new asphalt and the final wearing surface will be undertaken in stages at the intersection and on all approaches to the intersection. The first stage of works will commence on Sunday, 26 September 2021 and are expected to take approximately five weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am, from Sunday to Friday. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed. However, every effort will be made to minimise disruption to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times during the first stage of works, with speed and lane restrictions in place.

There will be some temporary access restrictions from Adelaide Street to Magill Road, and Dover Street to Portrush Road as works progress. Signage will be in place to provide advance notice of when these restrictions are required.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons the footpath and bike lane on the western side of Portrush Road will remain closed between Beulah Road and Dover Street. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours (see detour map). Every effort will be made to minimise impact to the community.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Public transport services will not be affected during the works, however if required, advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
