

Land Supply Dashboard – Quick Start Guide

WHAT IS THE LAND SUPPLY DASHBOARD?

The Land Supply Dashboard is an interactive tool displaying information on land supply and development activity across the Greater Adelaide Planning Region.

This dashboard has been prepared by Planning and Land Use Services (PLUS) to provide timely and transparent data on urban land supply and development activity through an online platform. The dashboard monitors key Greenfield and Strategic Infill areas and provides quarterly updates on available land supply and recent development activity. Data within the dashboard is available by region, monitoring area and residential estate. It is not intended to provide a full coverage of all land supply across the Greater Adelaide Planning Region but does cover key residential monitoring areas.

HOW CAN I USE THE LAND SUPPLY DASHBOARD?

The dashboard is best viewed from a desktop computer or laptop, however it can also be used on a mobile phone or tablet.

Users can navigate the dashboard using drop-down menus to select a region and/or monitoring area of interest. This selection updates the statistics and charts on the dashboard. Further detail within residential estates can be viewed in a pop-up by clicking on the map or by selecting from the list of estates that displays once a monitoring area has been selected.

The following section summarises the key features of the dashboard explaining how to navigate the tool. Instructions for use on PC and Mobile have been provided.



KEY DEFINITIONS

Development ready lots – Lots that have been approved through the land division process and are now ready to be, or have recently been, issued with a title. Includes sites where apartment buildings are under construction. In some locations, a development ready lot may still require local infrastructure coordination.

Proposed lots – Lots proposed in a land division application and have been either lodged or granted development approval. Includes apartment building sites with development approval.

Undeveloped zoned - Estimated potential lots over residential zoned land with no active plan of land division.

Future urban growth - Estimated potential lots over land not currently zoned, but identified for future residential growth within a relevant strategic plan (i.e. regional plan).

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Annual dwelling completions – number of residential dwellings that have been substantially completed within the year.

Dwellings approved – dwelling applications that have received full development approval. Data is sourced from development applications lodged through the PlanSA portal and do not include transitional applications (i.e. applications lodged under the previous planning system).

Greater Adelaide - Greater Adelaide Planning Region (GAPR) as defined in the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act, 2016.


Lots created – residential allotments that have had a certificate of title issued by Land Services SA.

Region – ten land supply sub-regions within Greater Adelaide Planning Region, used to provide high level reporting.

Monitoring area – residential development areas that have been identified as having significant potential (current or future).

Residential estates – marketed residential development estates.

Desktop Version: Land Supply Dashboard





Desktop Version: Dashboard Descriptions

#	Element Name	Description		
1	'i' button	Link to Land Supply Dashboard quick start guide (this document).		
2	Select region	Drop-down list allowing users to select a region of interest. Only one region can be selected at any time. A selection will see the map extent zoom to the extent of the region and the region boundary will flash. The dashboard items, included the charts and statistics, will be filtered to represent data for the selected region. The 'Select monitoring area' list will also be filtered.		
3	Select monitoring area	Drop-down list allowing users to select a monitoring area of interest. This list will be filtered if a region has been selected from the 'Select region' list. Only one monitoring area can be selected at any time. A selection will see the map extent zoom to the extent of the monitoring area, and the boundary will flash. The dashboard items, including the charts and statistics, will be filtered to represent data for the selected area. A list of residential estates within the monitoring area will be populated to the left of the map (see #10).		
4	Links menu	A list of related useful links. Provides a link back to the land supply page located on the PlanSA portal page.		
5	Information and data currency	A brief outline of the dashboard. Show current date of the data and expected update.		
6	Land supply table	Displays the calculated residential lots and estimated potential supply across the four land supply status types: <i>Development ready, Proposed, Undeveloped zoned</i> and <i>Future urban growth</i> . Hover text definitions for each term are provided in the platform and more detail can be found in the Glossary section of this document.		
7	Annual dwelling completions chart	Illustrates the number of dwellings built each year. Numbers are limited to regions and monitoring areas only. Data is updated quarterly.		
8	Lots created chart	Illustrates the number of new lots created by quarter. Will be filtered when selecting a region or monitoring area.		
9	Dwellings approved chart	Illustrates the number of dwelling approvals by quarter. Will be filtered when selecting a region or monitoring area.		
10	Region and Monitoring Area selection display	Displays the name of the selected region and /or monitoring area and identifies the location of the currently displayed statistics and charts on the dashboard.		
11	Residential estates list	List of residential estates within a selected monitoring area. Note: in some areas the monitoring area is the extent of the estate.		
12	Мар	Reflects the region, monitoring area and estates selected along with associated data. The level of detail displayed on the map changes with the zoom extent.		
13	Map legend button	Clickable button to display list of map layers displayed at current zoom level.		
14	Map layer toggle button	Enable interaction with map layers list to turn Infrastructure layers on and off.		
15	Dashboard refresh	Returns the map, charts and table to the default view first displayed when dashboard was opened from the PlanSA portal page.		
16	Estate description pop-up	Further details relating to selected estate, activated either by selecting a name from the estate list (10) or by clicking on an estate in the map. Note charts and statistics on the dashboard do not change when an estate is selected. Estate-level data is only displayed within the pop-up.		




Key	Element Name	Description		
1	Links menu	A list of related useful links. Provides a link back to the land supply page located on the PlanSA portal page.		
2	Region and monitoring area selection display	Displays the name of the selected region and /or monitoring area and identifies the location of the currently displayed statistics and charts on the dashboard.		
3	Selectors panel	Displays the selectors to choose a region, monitoring area or residential estate.		
4	Мар	Reflects the region, monitoring area and estates selected along with associated data. The level of detail displayed on the map changes with the zoom extent.		
5	Home button	Returns map view to default extent.		
6	Legend button	Displays list of map layers displayed at current zoom level		
7	Map layer toggle button	Enable interaction with map layers list to turn Infrastructure layers on and off.		
8	Table and charts	Scroll through and select from the available tables and charts. See below for further information on individual elements.		
9	Dashboard refresh	Returns the map, charts and table to the default view first displayed when dashboard was opened from the PlanSA portal page.		




Key	Element Name	Description		
1	Select a region	Drop-down list allowing users to select a region of interest. Only one region can be selected at any time. A selection will see the map extent zoom to the extent of the region and the region boundary will flash. The dashboard items, included the charts and statistics, will be filtered to represent data for the selected region. The 'Select monitoring area' list		
		will also be filtered.		
2	Select monitoring area	Drop-down list allowing users to select a monitoring area of interest. This list will be filtered if a region has been selected from the 'Select region' list. Only one monitoring area can be selected at any time. A selection will see the map extent zoom to the extent of the monitoring area, and the boundary will flash.		
		The dashboard items, including the charts and statistics, will be filtered to represent data for the selected area. A list of residential estates within the monitoring area will be populated to the left of the map (see key 3).		
3	Select an Estate	List of residential estates within a selected monitoring area (see Tab 5 below). Note: in some areas the monitoring area is the extent of the estate.		

Mobile View Version: Dashboard Description - Table and Chart Panels

Select from the menu at the bottom of the page to navigate too the table and chart panels.








Displays the estimated potential for residential lots across the four land supply status types: *Development ready, Proposed, Undeveloped zoned potential* and *Future urban growth potential*. These numbers reflect the region and monitoring area selections only.

3. Lots created graph




Summarises the total number of new lots created by quarter within the selected region or monitoring area.

4. Dwellings approved



Shows the number of dwelling approvals by quarter within the selected region or key monitoring area. This data is sourced from development applications lodged through the PlanSA Portal.

5. Annual dwelling completion



Summarises the total number of dwellings completed within the region or key monitoring area selected.

6. Selected estate details



Further details on a residential estate within the selected monitoring area are provided by selecting a name from the estate selector list. Note the data in the corresponding charts does not change.
