Princes Highway Corridor Upgrades

Walkers Tin Hut Road - update and temporary closure

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

Works at the junction of Walkers Tin Hut Road are underway. Pavement works are now required prior to completion.

How this affects you

Pavement works will start from Monday, 8 January 2024. During these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe.

Traffic on Princes Highway will be reduced to a single lane with onsite traffic controllers to control the direction of traffic. Outside of work hours traffic will be reopened to two lanes with speed restrictions in place.

To safely facilitate works at the junction, access to Walkers Tin Hut Road will be closed from Monday 15 January 2024 with a detour in place until Saturday 20 January 2024. Access to Walkers Tin Hut Road (from Princes Highway) will remain closed outside of work hours, with access via Emerald Road. Please see detour map overleaf.

Following completion of the pavement works, speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is fully completed. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

No works will be undertaken between Friday 22 December 2023 and Sunday 7 January 2024. Project completion at this location is expected in early February 2024, weather permitting.
