

South Eastern Freeway Upgrade Project

Works Update – Crafers Interchange

As part of the Heysen Tunnels upgrade, we are installing new Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) on the South Eastern Freeway.

What's happening:

We're doing trenching work to prepare for the installation of signs and traffic management infrastructure.

How this affects you:

Work will be occurring on the Adelaide bound ramp to the South Eastern Freeway. **The road will remain open at all times.**

One lane on the South Eastern Freeway will be temporarily closed alongside the Crafers Interchange Adelaide bound (on) ramp. All road users should observe traffic signage and follow direction of traffic management staff.

Speed restrictions will be in place and the road safety speed cameras at this location will still be in operation.

During the works, there will be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

There will be no change to public transport services.

In the event of a bushfire, other emergency, or on catastrophic fire days, all lanes will be open and posted speed limits will be reinstated.
