Streaky Bay Jetty Remediation

Works notice

We are upgrading the Streaky Bay Jetty to improve the jetty's structural integrity and lifespan.

These works are being undertaken as part of the SA Jetties Renewal Program that is in place to assist local councils to address critical works across the State's jetties. The program is designed to ensure ongoing public access to jetties, which provide significant economic, social, and environmental benefits for communities.

What's happening

We are undertaking remediation works on the Streaky Bay Jetty. Works will include installation of new structural piles, cross brace brackets and fenders to facilitate vessels berthing and mooring.

Site establishment works, including setting up the construction are ongoing with major works on the jetty commencing from Monday 21 October 2024, weather permitting.

The construction compound will be located between Alfred Terrace and the foreshore.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works the Streaky Bay Jetty will temporarily close to all users from Monday 21 October 2024 for the majority of the project.

Berthing and mooring will not be possible at the jetty during this time. The swimming enclosure will also be temporarily closed during the refurbishment works for safety reasons.

Access to the jetty's shelter on the landside of the jetty and the public toilets will be maintained throughout the project. Access to car parking adjacent Alfred Terrace will also be maintained.
