

South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrades

Remediation works

We are upgrading a series of bridges and culverts across South Australia to improve safety for road users and increase productivity and efficiency for the freight industry.

Works have been undertaken across multiple locations in South Australia.

What's happening

Remediation works are required to rectify minor defects identified at the stormwater culvert on the Princes Highway, approximately 8km north of Hatherleigh.

How this affects you

The Princes Highway will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe and ensure these works can be completed as quickly as possible there will be changes to traffic conditions throughout the work areas while works are in progress.

During work hours the Princes Highway will be reduced to a single lane where works are being undertaken. Traffic signage and traffic controllers will be in place to guide motorists through work areas.

Speed restrictions will be in place throughout work areas, including outside of working hours, until works are complete.
