Grange Road, Holbrooks Road and East Avenue intersection upgrade

Fact sheet - Vegetation management

We're upgrading the Holbrooks Road and East Avenue intersection to make it easier for you to cross Grange Road.

Tree and vegetation removal

We understand that trees are highly valued by the community. While every effort will be made to retain trees and vegetation, some removals will be required for this project.

As part of works to support the construction a number of trees within the immediate road reserve of the project area will be affected.

Impacts include the removal of 2 regulated trees. Additionally, approximately 49 amenity (unregulated) trees and shrubs will be removed.

All vegetation impacts will be managed and offset in accordance with legislative requirements and with our *Vegetation Impact Assessment Guideline*.

The impact to trees will continue to be assessed and minimised wherever possible as part of the construction process.

Taking care during tree removal and pruning

Where impacts cannot be avoided, all care and consideration will be taken in the removal and handling of vegetation.

Removal of impacted vegetation will be carefully supervised by an arborist.

Trees will be inspected prior to removal and if animals are found, they will be relocated by appropriately qualified professionals.

Revegetation strategy

As part of the project, new landscaping will be planted within the project area, incorporating approximately 80 semi-mature trees and over 870 shrubs.

Once established, the new landscaping will increase footpath shade, street appeal and enhance local biodiversity.

The landscape design and plant selection will complement the local biodiversity, assisted by careful selection of trees and shrubs suitable to the area.

Where offsets cannot be achieved through replacement planting due to space restrictions, an offset will be paid to the DIT Amenity Planting Fund.
