

Springbank Road, Colonel Light Gardens Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Commencement of works

We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians and cyclists to cross Springbank Road, Colonel Light Gardens

This project is funded by the \$168 million Road Safety Program, jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments.

What's happening

We are installing a new Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on Springbank Road in Colonel Light Gardens and Panorama, at the intersection with Eliza Place and Freeling Crescent.

This project will include:

- installation of new traffic lights, with countdown crossing timers
- new pedestrian ramps
- new line marking to facilitate safe crossings for pedestrians and cyclists
- audible push buttons
- retention of eastbound right turn lane onto Eliza Place.

Works will predominately be undertaken during the day, commencing from Monday, 29 September 2025, between the hours of 7am and 5pm.

Night works will take place from Wednesday 8 October 2025 to Saturday 25 October 2025 between the hours of 7pm and 5am, weather permitting.

Further night works will be required in mid-November, with advance notice to be provided.
