

Mount Barker Interchange Upgrade

Adelaide Road and South Eastern Freeway works notification

We are upgrading the Mount Barker Interchange to create better connections between Adelaide Hills and the freeway, supporting population growth.

What's happening

Works on the Mount Barker Interchange westbound (citybound) entry ramp are now underway.

Night works will commence in mid-April 2026 on Adelaide Road at various locations within the interchange. These night works include removal of median strips, lane realignment, barrier installation, earthworks and drainage works.

From mid-April 2026, works will also commence on the South Eastern Freeway to install temporary crossovers, located just east and west of the interchange.

These activities will take place at night to minimise disruption. Once barriers are installed on Adelaide Road, day works will commence behind the barriers.

How this affects you

There may be some noise disturbance during these works, but we will do our best to keep these to a minimum. Nearby properties will be notified ahead of night works.

To ensure the safety of all road users and workers, localised speed and lane restrictions will be in place while night works are undertaken. Following the installation of the new temporary crossovers on the South Eastern Freeway, localised speed restrictions will remain on South Eastern Freeway until the project is complete.

Please follow all signage and traffic controller instructions and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the interchange.
