

Edward Street, Clarence Gardens Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Project Update – June 2026

We're making it safer for pedestrians to cross Edward Street, Clarence Gardens

We are upgrading the existing Koala Crossing on Edward Street, outside Edwardstown Primary School, to a Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (PAC).

This upgrade will improve pedestrian safety and accessibility to the Edwardstown Primary School and nearby homes.

The project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian Governments as part of the River Torrens to Darlington Project.

What's happening

We asked the community to share local insights and feedback to help inform the final design of the Edward Street PAC.

Feedback received indicated strong support for the crossing upgrade, recognising it is a positive outcome to improve community safety.

Community feedback is now closed, we would like to thank everyone who provided feedback.

Next steps

Community insights and feedback is helping inform detailed design work which is underway. Construction is expected to start late 2026.

We will ensure that the community is kept informed as the project progresses, including advance notice ahead of construction work commencing.
