

Variable message gantry signage installation

Works update – Payneham Road, Felixstow

We are installing new variable message gantry signage at 16 locations along the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) corridor and surrounding major travel routes.

Variable message gantry signage displays live travel-time estimates, as well as alternative routes or roadworks notifications as needed. This information helps drivers make informed decisions while on their journey.

What's happening

Installation works for the new variable message gantry signage at Payneham Road, Felixstow, are progressing with completion scheduled for October 2026, weather permitting.

To minimise disruption to all road users, works will continue to be undertaken intermittently at night, between the hours of 8pm and 5am, from Sunday to Thursday.

Remaining works include:

- crash cushion and guardrail installation
- median concrete kerbing reinstatement
- footpath reinstatement
- asphalt reinstatement
- gantry signage installation.

Once installed, the gantry signage will undergo testing and commissioning before becoming operational.

Following completion, speed restrictions and the temporary barriers will be removed.

How this affects you

Pedestrians and road users

Payneham Road will remain open at all times during the works, with speed and lane restrictions in place as required.

Short-term pedestrian detours may be required at times to safely facilitate works. Clear signage will be in place during these times to direct pedestrians.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Residents and businesses

There will be some noise disturbance while these works are completed. However, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents wherever possible.

Access to businesses and residents will be maintained throughout the works, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
