Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken in the Gawler rail corridor adjacent the Para Road, Evanston, level crossing.

Location: adjacent the rail corridor at the Para Road level crossing (see map overleaf).

When:

On an intermittent basis between Monday, 1 July, and Monday, 15 July, inclusive, between 7am and 5pm (weather permitting).

Activities will include:

- Existing electrical overhead wires that currently cross over the railway line will be relocated to underground conduits.
- A new power pole will be installed.

Traffic management:

- Para Road will be under traffic management while these works are in progress. Speed and temporary lane restrictions may be required, and signage will be in place to advise motorists of changed conditions.
- Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times.

Details regarding any electricity outages will be managed and communicated by SA Power Networks.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses.
