

Karoonda Highway Upgrades

Project update

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is undertaking approximately 75 kilometres of pavement widening and shoulder sealing work between Pilchera Bore Road and the Murray Bridge Township.

This \$10 million project is jointly funded (80:20) by the Australian and South Australian governments to deliver essential safety upgrades and improvements along the Karoonda Highway.

These works will include:

- shoulder reconstruction and sealing;
- curve widening;
- drainage extensions; and
- road resurfacing.

Works commenced in January 2022 and are being undertaken from 6.30am to 5.30pm, seven days a week. Completion is expected in mid-2022, weather permitting.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Road users are asked to please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
