Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Start of Works Notice - Meningie Overtaking Lanes

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway Corridor by constructing two new overtaking lanes between Meningie and Salt Creek in the State's South-East. Overtaking lanes improve road safety by providing and encouraging safe overtaking opportunities for all road users.

This project forms part of the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade program which is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

The project will involve construction of a northbound and a southbound overtaking lane located approximately 12 kilometres south of Meningie.

Major works will commence early October 2022 and be completed late 2023, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken Monday to Friday between 6:30am and 5:30pm and Saturday 6:30am to 1:00pm. Some work outside of these times may be required with advance notice provided.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.



Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Impacts to vegetation have been carefully considered and will be minimised wherever practically possible.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
