

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety

Investigation works – Strathalbyn Road

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region. The road improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety, and increase fire resilience.

The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening:

Site investigation works including geotechnical investigation and survey works will be undertaken on Strathalbyn Road between Mount Barker Road, Aldgate and River Road, Mylor. These investigations will help us understand the current pavement conditions and support the planning for potential upgrades on this road.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, there will be speed and lane restrictions on Strathalbyn Road. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Access to businesses and surrounding properties will be maintained throughout these works, however we will contact you directly if there is a need to temporarily limit access.

Minor noise disturbances can be expected while works are being undertaken, but we will minimise any disturbance to residents as much as practically possible.
