

Barrier Highway, Main Road and Whyte Road intersection upgrade

Temporary changes to traffic arrangements

We are upgrading the intersections of Barrier Highway, Main Road and Whyte Road at Whyte Yarcowie

These upgrades will improve safety and freight efficiency and support regional economic growth and are jointly funded by the Australian (20%) and South Australian (80%) governments as part of the \$62.5 million Barrier Highway Corridor Upgrade.

What's happening

Night works to prepare the road surface for a final asphalt seal at the intersections of Barrier Highway, Main Road and Whyte Road at Whyte Yarcowie will be undertaken from:

- Monday 23 February 6pm to 6am Tuesday 24 February
- Tuesday 24 February 6pm to 6am Wednesday 25 February

How this affects you

Barrier Highway will remain open at all times.

During these works the highway will be reduced to a single lane with traffic lights in place to control traffic.

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place throughout the works area for the duration of the project

Some traffic delays can be expected, and motorists are encouraged to plan their journey ahead. Onsite signage will alert road users of the temporary changes to traffic conditions.

This project is expected to be complete mid 2026.
