



Raglan Avenue, Edward Street and South Road network upgrade

Project Update - April 2026

We're improving east-west connections in Edwardstown and saving time

A new link road has been constructed as part of the Raglan Avenue, Edward Street and South Road network upgrade to improve safety for all road users. This project forms part of the \$850 million Broader Network Upgrade package of works as part of the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project.

The new link road will open to traffic **early April 2026**.

This will include a new dedicated through lane, and a new dedicated right-turn lane at the intersection of South Road, Edward Street and the new link road.

Once the new link road is open, the following traffic arrangements will be in place:

- permanent removal the right hand turn from South Road into Raglan Avenue and removal of the signalised intersection at South Road and Raglan Avenue
- access to Raglan Avenue from South Road, will be available via the new link road.

Ongoing Raglan Avenue works

Following the removal of the traffic signals on South Road, works will continue along Raglan Avenue between South Road and the new roundabout.

To safely undertake these works the following temporary closures will be in place until mid 2026, see detour map overleaf.

- **Night-time closures** - Raglan Avenue, between South Road and the new roundabout, from 7:00pm to 6:00am
- **Day-time closures** – Raglan Avenue, between South Road and the new roundabout will be reduced to westbound traffic only.

These temporary closures will allow us to safely construct new kerbing, footpath, pavement, landscaping and lighting.

Access to Castle Plaza and local businesses will always be maintained via South Road and Raglan Avenue.

Bus Stop 15

Bus Stop 15 on Raglan Avenue, north side and south side, will be relocated and open in their new permanent locations from Friday 10 April 2026, please see map over the page.

How this affects you

The signalised right hand turn on Edward Street to South Road will be operational; however, some traffic management will be in place to support construction of the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project midpoint substation. Additional information is available on the T2D website here www.t2d.sa.gov.au

To keep everyone safe while we carry out works, we will have onsite signage and traffic controllers in place. Please take care when travelling through the area and follow the directions of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times; however, if there is a need for short-term access impacts, we will contact you directly in advance.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed; however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

What's next

Works along Raglan Avenue, South Road and Price Street include kerbing, driveways, footpath, landscaping, drainage, lighting and relocation activities will continue.

Works on the new signalised intersection at the Castle Plaza Shopping Centre entrance on South Road and Price Street will commence late April through to mid 2026, weather permitting. We will provide more information closer to the date.

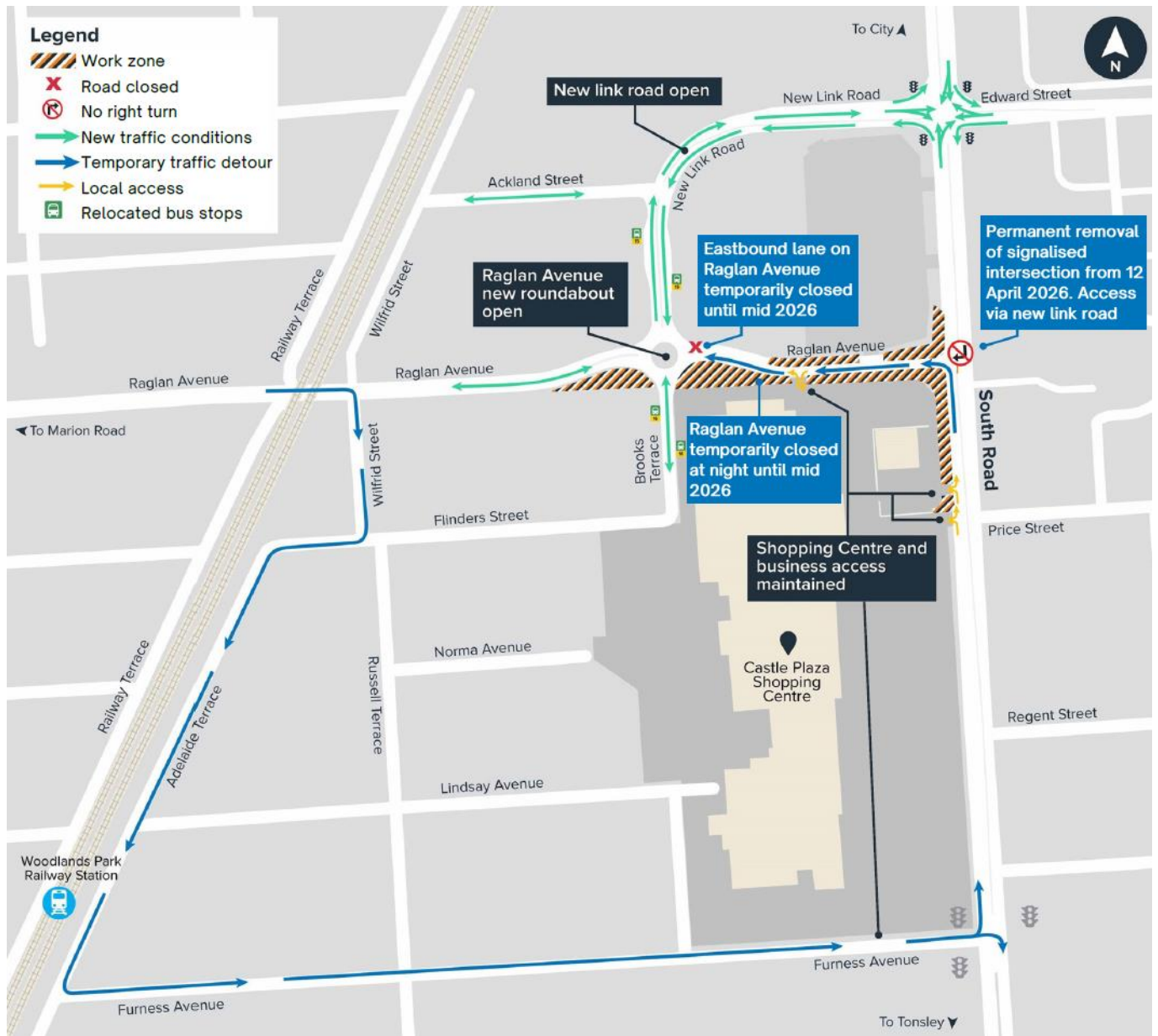
