NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CHANGES TO TRAFFIC CONDITIONS, OCEAN STEAMERS ROAD, PORT ADELAIDE

Temporary traffic changes on a section of Ocean Steamers Road, Port Adelaide, will come into effect on Friday 26 May 2006 to 23 June 2006 (weather permitting) as part of overall work for Stages 2 and 3 of the Port River Expressway project.

The changes will occur on a 100-metre section of Ocean Steamers Road, north of the intersection of Francis Street and Ocean Steamers Road, Port Adelaide.

The temporary change in traffic conditions will enable land piling works for the Port River Expressway rail bridge to be undertaken in a timely and safe manner.

Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout the duration of the works with a 25kph speed limit in place during normal construction hours of 7.00 am to 5.00 pm, Monday to Saturday. A 40kph speed limit will apply at all other times.

Partial lane closures will occur as these works progress, with signage and temporary traffic signals in place to direct motorists during the works.
