



Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

Night Works Notification

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Springbank, Daws and Goodwood Roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$61 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian Governments.

While the majority of works continue to be undertaken during the day, night works are required to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Night works will be undertaken from Sunday, 27 June 2021, through to Friday, 23 July 2021, weather permitting.

Hours of work are between **7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.**

The works will be undertaken in stages at various locations and include the construction of medians, the placement of the final layer of asphalt and line marking of the new road surface.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise the disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

The new intersection will remain open to traffic at all times other than the following:

- **Tuesday, 29 June 2021 and Wednesday, 30 June 2021 between 7pm and 6am**, when access to **Daws Road will be closed** between Boorman Avenue and the new intersection; and
- **Sunday, 27 June 2021 and Thursday, 01 July 2021 between 8pm to 6am**, when access to **Springbank Road will be closed** between Eliza Place and the new intersection.

The intersection will re-open each morning at 6am. Local access will be maintained at all times for residents, buses and emergency services vehicles.

Public transport services will remain operational however, bus stops may require temporary relocation. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.
