

# Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

## Start of Works Notice – North of Millicent to Tantanoola

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway Corridor, from north of Millicent to Tantanoola. This project forms part of the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade program, which is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

Upgrade works on this section of the Princes Highway, north of Millicent to Tantanoola in the State's South-East, will include:

- construction of a northbound and a southbound overtaking lane located approximately seven kilometres north of Millicent;
- eastbound and westbound overtaking lane extensions at approximately thirteen kilometres south-east of Millicent; and
- junction upgrade at Furner Road, Millicent;

Major works at all locations will commence **early October 2022 and be completed late 2023**, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken **Monday to Friday between 6:30am and 5:30pm and Saturday 6:30am to 1:00pm**. Some work outside of these times may be required with advance notice provided.

### Traffic Management

#### Overtaking lanes

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

#### Furner Road, Junction Upgrade

To safety undertake these works, the Princes Highway will be reduced to a single lane of traffic with temporary traffic signals in place to control the direction of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be in place throughout the work area. Outside of working the hours the highway will re-open to a single lane of traffic in each direction with speed restrictions in place.

Junction upgrade works will include road widening, lengthening the existing right hand turn into Furner Road and, new line marking. See concept map overleaf for reference.

## What to expect

Access for emergency service vehicles and public transport will be maintained at all times during the works.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Impacts to vegetation have been carefully considered and will be minimised wherever practically possible.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

The Department appreciates your cooperation and patience while these important works are undertaken.

## Additional works

Walkers Tin Hut Road Junction upgrade will commence late 2022, weather permitting. Works will include road widening, construction of a dedicated right hand turn into Walkers Tin Hut Road and new line marking. Advanced notice of these works will be provided.
