

## Street Tree Species Suitable for Adelaide Streetscapes

*This is not an exhaustive list and is not intended to limit the planting of other species. The list will be reviewed and updated in future to provide information on additional species suited to Adelaide streetscapes and future climate conditions.*

*When selecting species, consideration should be given to the location, height, depth, and extent of underground and above ground services, as well as the potential for tree root systems and canopies to damage pavements or interfere with street lighting.*
