Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Pedestrian detour, Glen Osmond Road, Frewville

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, works to construct new footpaths, kerbing and road pavements, install road lighting, and underground infrastructure are required.

These works will commence soon on the northern side of Glen Osmond Road.

What to expect

To minimise the impact to road users, these works will be undertaken at night.

Works are scheduled to commence on Sunday, 5 March and are expected to be complete by late April 2023, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am. No works will be undertaken on Saturday night.

To safely facilitate these works, the existing footpath on the northern side of Glen Osmond Road between bus stop 5 and Fullarton Road will be temporarily closed throughout the above work period (both day and night).

Pedestrians will be directed to detour via the signalised crossing on Glen Osmond Road, along the southern side of Glen Osmond Road, to then access the Fullarton Road intersection.

Pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage and take care when travelling through the area.
