Site investigation works to commence for the South Australian Government's \$1.5 million election commitment to plan, design and construct a signalised intersection and pedestrian crossing at the John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road junction, Elizabeth Vale.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to provide feedback late last year. This feedback has been provided to the project team to help inform the development of the concept design.

Investigation works to also inform the design will shortly commence. Activities will include geotechnical drilling at the junction.

Works will be undertaken between 9am and 4pm Monday, 23 January and Tuesday, 24 January **2023**, weather permitting.

Lane and speed restrictions will be in place during the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and roads.

Minor noise disturbances can be expected at times whilst these works are being completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.
