

# Road Safety Program

## Main South Road Upgrade, Myponga to Second Valley

**We are upgrading Main South Road from Myponga to Second Valley, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users**

These works form part of the \$168 million Road Safety Program 2023-2025, jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments.

### What's happening

Works are recommencing between Myponga and Second Valley, with safety barrier installation, shoulder sealing and vegetation management occurring at various locations.

Works commenced from Myponga and are moving progressively towards Second Valley.

### How this affects you

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area during work hours. Outside of work hours, speed restrictions will remain in place until all works are complete

Please take care when traveling through the area, plan your trips, and follow the directions of onsite traffic controllers.

**Main South Road will remain open at all times.**
