

Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place Intersection Upgrade

Commencement of works

We're upgrading the Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place intersection

These works are jointly funded 50:50 by the Australian and South Australian governments through the Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program, which replaces the Heavy Vehicle Safety and Productivity Program (HVSPP).

What's happening

Works are commencing on the Porter Street, Liverpool Street (Lincoln Highway) and Railway Place intersection in Port Lincoln.

These works will improve freight efficiency, enhance safety and provide better access for pedestrians.

The project will include the installation of traffic signals at the intersection, creating a pedestrian crossing on all four approaches, and new line marking, street lighting, kerbing and landscaping. See concept image overleaf.

How this affects you

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, some restrictions will need to remain in place, until completion.

Between the hours of 7am and 6pm

Some night works as required, with advance notice.

To minimise disruptions to local businesses and traffic, works will be undertaken in stages and move progressively across all four approaches of the intersection.

Most construction works will be undertaken during the day, with some night works, as required. Advance notice will be provided prior to any night works commencing.

Access to businesses will be maintained at all times, however, if there is the need for short-term access impacts, we will contact you directly in advance.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby properties as much as practically possible.
