Kangarilla Road, Clarendon to Kangarilla – Night works

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region

The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening

Resurfacing works along Kangarilla Road between Fairlane Road, Kangarilla to Oval Road, Clarendon are progressing well.

To minimise the disruption to road users works will continue to be undertaken at night.

How this affects you

Speed and lane restrictions will remain in place throughout the work area during work hours. During night works temporary traffic signals will be in place to manage traffic. Outside of work hours, lane restrictions will be lifted with speed restrictions remaining in place as required.

Please plan your trips, observe signage and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times. If short term access restrictions are required, impacted residents will be contacted directly.

We thank you for your understanding while we undertake these important safety upgrade.
