

Main Road, Coromandel Valley Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Project update – June 2026

The new PAC will make crossing Main Road safer and more convenient, improving safety, access and connectivity to the Coromandel Valley Primary School.

The new Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (PAC) on Main Road, Coromandel Valley is now operational. The PAC will operate at all times.

As part of this safety improvement, the northbound bus stop 35 on Main Road has been indented to minimise queue lengths across the PAC.

Minor finishing works

Landscaping and minor finishing works will continue until late June 2026, weather permitting. These works will be undertaken from Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm.

To keep everyone safe, speed and intermittent lane restrictions will be in place during this time. Please continue to follow all road safety signage and traffic directions while works are underway.

New 40km school speed limit

To further support safer travel to and from school, a new time-based 40 km/h speed limit is now in place on Main Road around the PAC and Coromandel Valley Primary School. The 40 km/h speed limit applies on school days when children are travelling to and from school during the following times:

- Between 8:00 am to 9:30 am, and
- Between 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

This excludes weekends, public holidays and State school holidays.
