

# Military Road Pedestrian Actuated Crossing Early Works and Service Relocations

**As part of the State Government's election commitment to enhance pedestrian safety, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport will design and install a pedestrian actuated crossing on Military Road. Funding of \$1.1 million has been allocated to this project.**

The pedestrian actuated crossing will be installed on Military Road between St Albans Terrace and Recreation Parade, immediately to the north of Jena Close. The new crossing will improve access to Point Malcolm Reserve and contribute to improved safety when crossing Military Road.

## What to expect

Further early works and service relocations are required and will continue along Military Road, between Recreation Parade and St Albans Terrace. These works are now **expected to be completed by late June 2023**. Works will continue to be undertaken **Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 5pm**, weather permitting. No works will be undertaken on weekends.

Works include the relocation of telecommunications and APA Gas infrastructure. Individual service providers, including APA Gas and Telecommunications providers, will advise separately of any potential service interruptions.

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Please follow the directions of on-site traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Access to Jena Close will be maintained by traffic control.

## Pedestrian Detour

The footpath on the eastern side of Military Road will also be temporarily closed from Thursday, 25 May 2023 for the duration of the works. A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place around the work site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage.

Access to properties near the work area will be maintained during the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. Access will be maintained for emergency services vehicles at all times

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.

Construction of this pedestrian actuated crossing is still expected to commence in mid- 2023 and will be completed by late 2023. Advance notification of these works will be provided. We appreciate your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
