# Cape Jervis and Kangaroo Island Ports Upgrade



## **Project Update**

Major works to upgrade the port infrastructure at Cape Jervis and Penneshaw are well underway. This update provides an overview of ongoing and upcoming works at both locations.

### Penneshaw piling update

Initial piling works at Penneshaw, are scheduled to commence from Tuesday 3 September 2024 for approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

Works will be undertaken during the day, between the hours of 7am and 6pm utilising purpose-built barges on the water. Ferry services will be maintained throughout these works.

We are utilising a 'bored' piling method, enabling piles to be installed directly into pre-bored holes. This type of piling produces significantly less noise compared to driven piles, minimising noise and vibration levels to the community and local environment. #### **Additional works at Cape Jervis**

There will be increased activity around the Cape Jervis port precinct as the SeaLink managed works commence. The SeaLink works include upgrades to the vehicle loading area and loading ramps, and the ferry maintenance berth adjacent the terminal.

To accommodate these works there will be changes to existing traffic and pedestrian movements, some temporary restrictions to existing parking areas, and an increase in construction vehicle movements. To keep everyone safe, please take care when moving around the car parks, and follow the directions of onsite workers and signage.

We appreciate that works within the port precincts at Cape Jervis and Penneshaw have an impact on the community and ferry users and we would like to thank you for your patience and understanding while these critical works are undertaken.
