NOTICE OF CHANGES TO TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

TEMPORARY PARTIAL CLOSURE OF PERKINS DRIVE, PORT ADELAIDE

As part of works for Stages 2 & 3 of the Port River Expressway project, the section of Perkins Drive between Francis Street and Eastern Parade will be temporarily closed from 7am on Saturday 16 June to 5pm on Sunday 17 June 2007.

During this closure, works will be undertaken to install a rail level crossing on Perkins Drive, connecting the Port River Expressway Rail Bridge and associated new rail lines into the existing rail network. Rail signals for this crossing will also be installed at this time, but will not be commissioned until the Rail Bridge is operational in late 2007.

Motorists are advised that access to the Grand Trunkway and Ocean Steamers Road from Port Adelaide will be provided via Francis Street and Eastern Parade during the closure. Motorists travelling westbound on the Port River Expressway will be required to exit at Eastern Parade to access the Grand Trunkway and Ocean Steamers Road via Eastern Parade.

All detours will be clearly marked.

Access to Incitec Pivot and Symons & Clark Transport will be maintained for local traffic only through the intersection of Perkins Drive and Francis Street.
