# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

# Upcoming night works and temporary bus stop and pedestrian access changes

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

During works on this upgrade, the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

While the majority of these works are being undertaken during the day, some night works are required to ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently. There will also be some temporary bus stop relocations and pedestrian access changes required around the intersection to safely facilitate these works.

# **Upcoming night works**

From late September 2022, night works will be undertaken in various locations through and around the intersection as required between the hours of 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday, until late November 2022. Some works may also need to be undertaken on Friday or Saturday nights and in adjacent side streets.

Advance notice of future night works will be provided as works progress.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works during the day or early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphalting works are underway.

The project team will contact individual property owners whose access is affected by the works.

#### **Bus stop changes**

To safely facilitate intersection widening works, there will also be some temporary bus stop relocations and pedestrian access changes around the intersection.

Bus stop 5 on Fullarton Road (west side) will be temporarily closed from 6am Monday, 31 October 2022 until late April 2023. During this time, patrons will need to use bus stop 5 on Glen Osmond Road (south side).

Bus stop 5 on Fullarton Road (east side) and bus stop 5 on Glen Osmond Road (north side) will remain operational throughout the works.

# Pedestrian access changes

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times throughout the works however there will be some temporary changes to access. During night works, as pedestrians will be temporarily relocated onto the roadway behind traffic control, i.e., traffic cones and traffic control vehicles. During the day, pedestrians will be directed to temporary footpaths along back of the newly widened road.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
