

# Yorktown Road and Adams Road Roundabout

## Commencement of Works Notice

**We are improving safety and reducing waiting times for motorists turning right out of Adams Road onto Yorktown Road, Elizabeth Downs.**

This upgrade forms part of the State Government's election commitments, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs.

### What's happening

Construction works are starting soon on the Yorktown Road and Adams Road roundabout at Elizabeth Downs. This upgrade includes construction of a new single lane roundabout, new and upgraded LED lighting, new kerb and gutter, and upgraded road surfaces to improve traffic flow and safety for all road users.

Major construction is planned to be complete in March 2025, weather permitting.

### How this affects you

**From Thursday 26 September 2024**, initial activities will start on site (including site establishment and vegetation removal). These activities will take around one week to complete prior to construction commencing. During these works, there will be speed restrictions in place.

**From Tuesday 8 October 2024 until late 2024 there will be no access to and from Adams Road from Yorktown Road.** To keep everyone safe, local detours will be required, including outside of working hours. Please follow signage and the directions of onsite traffic controllers.

**Yorktown Road will remain open to two way traffic at all times.** Speed restrictions will be in place during and outside of work hours until all works are completed.
